## **Accelerated Route to Fellowship Program**

The **Accelerated Route to Fellowship** program is designed for practising lawyers and arbitrators with at least ten years experience. The program is a combination of lectures, problem-solving and role play. It focuses on applicable laws and procedures for the conduct of efficient arbitration hearings and the writing of high quality arbitral decisions in complex international cases. The program concludes with an Award Writing examination. With an experienced training team, the ratio of faculty to participants is 1:6, ensuring the highest quality training and learning. The participants analyze many of the current legal issues and practical challenges facing parties to international commercial arbitrations and arbitrators. Completion of the program is a key step toward CI Arb accreditation.
